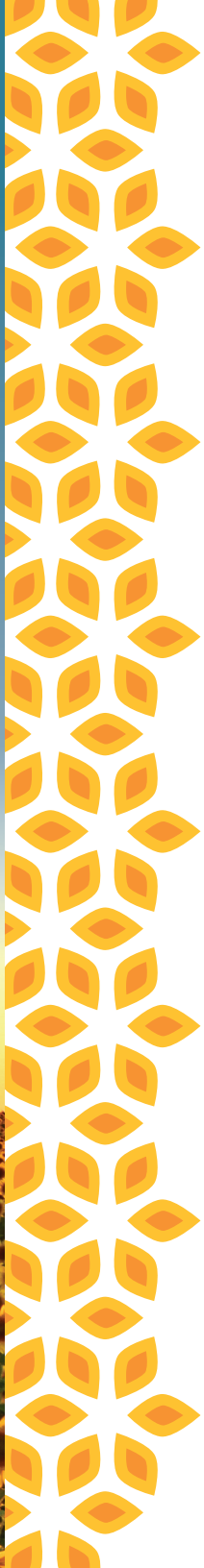

# Course Overview
